

give sb/get A for effort အောင်မြင်တာမအောင် မြင်တာထားကြိုးစားအားထုတ်မှုအတွက် အဆင့် A ပေးပြီး ချီးကျူး(ခံရ) *The President gave him A for effort.* (တစ်ခါတစ်လေ E for effort လို့ပြောတယ်။ E က effort ကိုဆိုလိုတာ။)

A to Z 1. . . အကြောင်းစလယ်ဆုံး စုံလင်ပြည့်စုံစွာ ဖော်ပြချက် *She wrote an A to Z on Myanmar cooking.* 2. know/learn etc from A to Z အကုန်၊ တစ်ခုစတုန့်ဆိုတဲ့သဘော *It seems she knows about the matter from A to Z.*

from point A to point B နားမည်မဖော်ပြဘဲပြောတဲ့ အခါသုံးစကား *We've covered the area from point A to point B.*

be taken aback (by) ရုတ်တရက်အံ့အားသင့် *I was taken aback by her rude reply.* > *She was taken aback when she saw me in her bedroom.*

abandon your house/ship/car/family etc 1 စွန့်ခွာစွန့်ပြစ်တဲ့သဘော *He abandoned his family.* > *The driver has abandoned his car and fled.*

2 abandon plan/project/attempt/dream etc မေ့ပြစ်၊လက်လျှော့လိုက်တဲ့သဘော *I've abandoned my dream to become a novelist.*

abandon yourself to a feeling/emotion etc lit (ဖြစ်ချင်တာဖြစ်တော့ဆိုပြီး)မိမိကိုယ်ကရမစိုက်ဘဲလွတ်ထားတဲ့သဘော *He abandoned himself to his feelings and soon got into a big trouble.*

abandon oneself to sth ဖြစ်ချင်ရာဖြစ်ဆိုပြီး(သာယာမှု၊ တောင့်တမှု၊ ဆန္ဒစသည်)စိတ်ကိုလွှတ်ပေး *She abandoned herself to his advances(sensual kisses).*

with gay/ wild/total/reckless abandon *Shwe Ban usually does things with reckless abandon.* > *He danced with wild abandon.*

abase yourself to/before ခယဝပ်တွား *The politician abased himself to the voters.* > *The wrongdoer abased himself before the crowd.* > *We abased ourselves before the Sayadaw.*

show no sign of abating လျော့သွားမယ့်ပုံမရှိတဲ့သဘော *The storm/pain shows no sign of abating.*

ABC of sth လုပ်ငန်းအခြေခံ(ကကြီးခကျေး)သဘော / *know the ABC of car maintenance.*

abdicate the throne ထီးနန်းစွန့် *The king was forced to abdicate the throne.*

in a moment of (mental)aberration/(temporary) aberration ခဏသတိလက်လွတ်သွား၊စိတ်လေသွားတဲ့သဘော *In a moment of aberration she lost her virginity.*

aid and abet မကောင်းမှုကိုအားပေးကူညီ *Her brother aided and abetted her in the killing.* > *He was charged with aiding and abetting a swindler.*

be held in abeyance ခေတ္တဆိုင်းထား *The project is held in abeyance for two weeks.*

fall into abeyance ခေတ္တရပ်ထား *The plan falls into abeyance for lack of money.*

abhor injustice/unfairness etc ရွံ့ရှာမုန်းတီး *They say they abhor all the injustices of the system.*

in/with abhorrence ရွံ့မုန်း *She looked at him in abhorrence.*

can't abide sb/sth သည်းမခံ၊လက်မခံနိုင် *I can't abide his rude behaviour.* > *I like her but I can't abide her dog.*

abide by rule/law/agreement etc လိုက်နာ *Players must abide by the rules.* > *Both men agreed to abide by the court's decision.*

love/earth etc abides ခိုင်တည်မြဲ *Men come and go, but earth abides.* > *I wish our love will abide till the end of our lives.*

has/show ability to do sth အစွမ်း *He has an outstanding musical/artistic/athletic ability.* > *He has a surprising ability to handle problems.* > *The magician shows his ability to struggle out of danger.*

to the best of your ability အစွမ်းကုန် *It is time now to work to the best of your ability.*

in abject poverty/misery/failure အရမ်းနိမ့်ကျ၊ ဆင်းရဲဆိုးရွား *I'm surprized to see that villagers are living in abject poverty.* > *She committed suicide in abject failure.*

be set ablaze မီးရှို့ *The building was set ablaze during the revolt.*
